

Transdisciplinary Design Management Framework for the Redevelopment of Post-Industrial Cities

My doctoral research aims to establish a transdisciplinary design framework for the redevelopment of post-industrial cities and the development of urban codes. Industrialization is a worldwide phenomenon that many towns have faced through the years. Most of those cities are now facing a post-industrial decline characterized by empty brown-fields, unsafe neighbourhoods, and inclusion problems. The understanding of different assets of post-industrial redevelopment, and contribution of urban form and spatial arrangement to post-industrial recovery, together with the identification of outstanding lessons and common patterns, will allow the development of a framework to map problems and issues in post-industrial cities.
